Oceanfront hotel set to unveil multimillion-dollar renovation (Photos)

The Singer Oceanfront Resort in Palm Beach County is nearing completion of a multimillion-dollar renovation, which is slated to be finished in late spring.

A spokeswoman for the Hilton hotel said the property will host a post-renovation celebration in May to acknowledge the remodel. The 223-room resort is in Riviera Beach at 3700 N. Ocean Drive. It's located on a four-mile stretch on Singer Island.



The Singer's top-to-bottom renovation includes its guest rooms, suites, balconies, lobby, pool deck, outdoor pavilion, common areas, meeting rooms and more than 10,000 square feet of function space for special events.

The resort has added three new dining concepts: Caretta Caretta, a seafood-inspired signature restaurant; Top Shell, a beachfront bar; and The Market at Singer, a grab-and-go store that serves pre-packaged food and drink.





Davidson Resorts, an Atlanta-based subsidiary of Davidson Hospitality Group, operates The Singer Oceanfront Resort.

"While Palm Beach is a popular travel destination, we're excited to unveil this new resort experience that will undoubtedly put a spotlight on Singer Island," Davidson Resorts Executive Vice President Steve Contos said.

The Singer Oceanfront Resort was formerly known as the Hilton Singer Island Oceanfront/Palm Beaches Resort. It has been converted into a Curio Collection by Hilton hotel, a premium brand owned by the Virginia-based Hilton Worldwide Holdings Inc. (NYSE: HLT).
